 - Compulsory: Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics, Citizenship and Social Development, Physical Education* Elective: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Chinese History, Geography, Economics, Information and Communication Technology, Tourism and Hospitality Studies, Design and Applied Technology, Business, Accounting and Financial Studies (Accounting), Business, Accounting and Financial Studies (Management), Health Management and Social Care, Visual Arts, Mathematics (Extended Part - Module 1)

Complete the application form with a recent photo attached together with the pre-printed EDB "Application Form for Secondary One Discretionary Place" (with the "EDB's Copy", "School's Copy", "Parent's Copy intact). Submit the forms together with the following supporting documents# in person to the school general office or via the SSPA e-Platform:
 - 1. Photocopies of each term's report cards for P.5 and 6
 - 2. Photocopy of Hong Kong Identity Card
 - 3. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
 - 4. A self-addressed envelope with postage of \$2.2 (clearly indicating the student's name and address)
 - (Applicants are not required to submit recommendation letters from their primary schools.)
